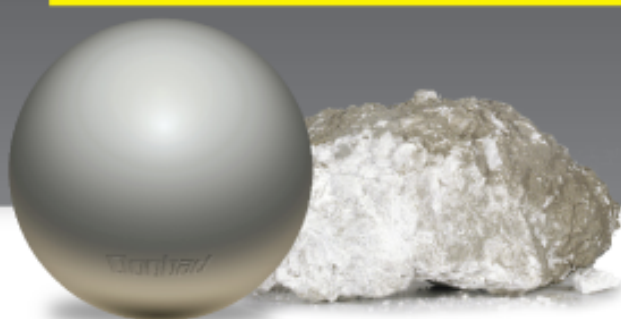

A new culture, a new level of safety.

Newcastle recently celebrated a fantastic achievement:
3 years Lost Time Injury Free.

Everyone involved in this achievement deserves hearty congratulations. After all, a result like this only comes about through hard work, persistence, passion and a belief in the cause.

What began as a strong commitment from all levels of management, a dedication to creating a new attitude and an investment in physical improvements like guarding and lighting has resulted in a new, safety-first culture we can all be proud of.

Gone are the days where "the job comes first".
And welcome to the new era, where people come first.

The Delta Behavioural Safety Model has been a great help to us. All supervisors, foremen and operators on site have received the necessary training, and many of the concepts form part of various toolbox talks and general discussions.

Other changes have also assisted in creating this culture change. Morning meetings have safety as the first item on the agenda, safety walks by management and safety interrupts have been implemented, as well as a reward and recognition programme. And a culture of blaming for any incidents has been replaced by a thorough, rational investigation where lessons learned can inform future improvements. The "take 5" tool has been central to this success, and in changing the mindset when planning a job.

Two of the largest grinding mills arrive

They're bigger than big.

It was a massive occasion when one of Donhad's customers took delivery of two of the world's largest and most powerful grinding mills.

The Sino Iron Project in WA took delivery of the ball mill and Autogenous Grinding (AG) mill, two of 12 mills that'll be responsible for grinding millions of tonnes of magnetite iron ore into a fine concentrate.

Donhad supplied all of the external fasteners for the mills in a project which was heralded by CITIC Pacific Mining (CPM) as being the beginning of a new era in the large-scale downstream processing of iron ore in the state.

New Robots at Bassendean Site

Robots of the future are here.

Two manufacturing sites will soon be benefiting from recently installed robots. The robots, commissioned by Argon Technologies WA are ABB technology supplied and will be fully operational in September.

The benefits of these robots to the manufacturing sites will be two-fold: the risk of injury will be reduced as there will be no person/machine interaction, and the quality of the final product will be improved due to the incredible consistency of placement in the die that the robot is able to deliver.



Whilst still only in the commissioning phase, the signs are extremely positive and Donhad has plans for an automation project in every manufacturing site. The response from the people in the plant has been overwhelmingly positive, and, as the automation projects unfold over the next 24 months, we take pleasure in saying: Welcome to the future.
